In Eqs. (29), (30), and (31) of the above paper, the expression J(S, O) should always be J(O, S) as in Eqs. (4) and (5). This is simply a typo. The subsequent calculations are correct.

More seriously, in the result given in Eq. (53) the term  $1 - \Psi_O$  should be  $1 - 2\Psi_O + \Psi_S$ . All the following mistakes are consequences of this error: The same error follows in Eq. (55). Consequently the first line of Eq. (58) should be

$$-\frac{1}{\mathcal{H}_S}\Psi_S-(\eta_O-\eta_S-\mathcal{H}_S^{-1})\Psi_O.$$

Finally, the second line of Eq. (59) should be

$$\frac{1}{(\eta_O - \eta_S)\mathcal{H}_S}(\Psi_S - \Psi_O) - \Psi_S.$$
